



RESCUE 217

Rescue 217 is a 2000 Club Car golf cart donated by OAFR EMT Carl Ridgway in 2001. 217 is utilized by OAFR at community events like the AuSable River Canoe Marathon, Art on the Beach and 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks. The unit is primarily stationed at Oscoda Schools sporting events to provide immediate, on-site medical treatment. 217 features a custom patient/equipment rack fabricated by Oscoda Schools and is designed to transport patients from the field or other congested areas to an awaiting ambulance.



## DISASTER 215

215 is a 2000 Haulmark 8' trailer and was purchased in 2000 with assistance from a North Central Michigan Community Foundation Grant. The unit was stocked with supplies and equipment with assistance from an Iosco County Community Foundation grant. The trailer is equipped and designed to respond to situations involving a large



number of patients. A dozen backboards, cervical collars, burn sheets, splints, oxygen masks & tanks, blankets, water and triage supplies are carried on the unit. The trailer is also equipped with a dozen body bags and 3 dozen personal hygiene kits. OAFR's disaster unit is the only one in this part of the State.



OUR STATION



OAFR currently shares a station with Iosco County EMS on Sunset Street in AuSable Township. Completed in 2001, the building has 4 vehicle bays and a complete crew quarters for on-duty personnel. Iosco County generously donates the space to OAFR in exchange for grounds & building maintenance and call response assistance.
